

New York State Law mandates that all backflow prevention devices must be tested annually by a certified backflow tester. Each year the results of the test must be filed with the Plainview Water District. Upon approval the law requires that the District forward the test information to the Nassau County Department of Health for their records. In an effort to consolidate the District's administrative procedures, and to insure compliance with the Nassau County Department of Health regulations, the District will now send out the first request for compliance beginning in March of each year.

You may retain the services of your own certified tester or you may [Click Here](#) for a list of New York State Department of Health certified testers located in Nassau County. Upon completion, the tester will mail the proper paperwork to the District for review and approval.
