Smart or weather-based irrigation controllers can be effective tools for reducing landscape water usage. More efficient watering means less waste and healthier plants.

PROGRAM'S PURPOSE

Lawn irrigation systems are the single greatest users of water around the home. By being smart about your lawnwatering habits, you save water, increase the health of your lawn and gardens, and reduce your water bill.

DID YOU KNOW?

- The Plainview Water District has pumped an average of 1.84 billion gallons of water from our aquifer over the past four years.
- 60 percent of the yearly total is pumped between May and September.
- It is common for conventional irrigation timers to apply twice the amount of water needed for lawns and gardens.
- A self-adjusting smart irrigation controller automatically turns on or off in response to local weather data and adjusts irrigation system usage daily.

BENEFITS OF INSTALLING A SMART IRRIGATION CONTROLLER

SAVE MONEY

While results will vary, smart irrigation controllers have shown to decrease irrigation water consumption by more than 30 percent. In fact, a neighboring water district piloted this technology at their headquarters and saved more than 52,000 gallons of water. That can equate to as much as a \$100 savings per household per season.

SAVE TIME

Set it and forget it. Smart controllers automatically adjust watering schedules so you don't have to.

SAVE WATER

Smart controllers are designed to optimize landscape water usage to prevent over-watering, which is a common problem. Smart irrigation controller systems use information such as local weather conditions, plant type and soil moisture to determine your plants' water needs.

IMPROVED LANDSCAPE HEALTH

Plants thrive under optimal watering conditions, and smart irrigation controllers can easily be programmed to provide your landscaping with the correct amount of water.
